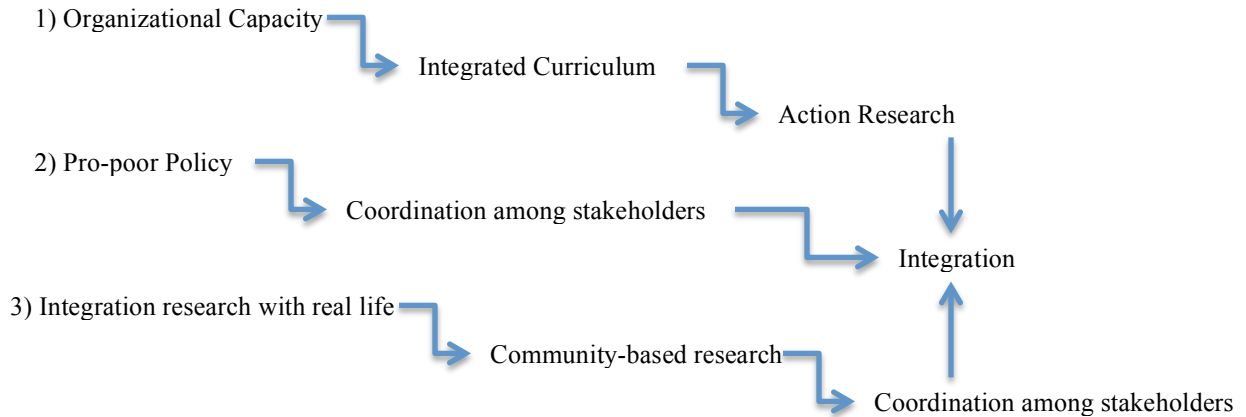

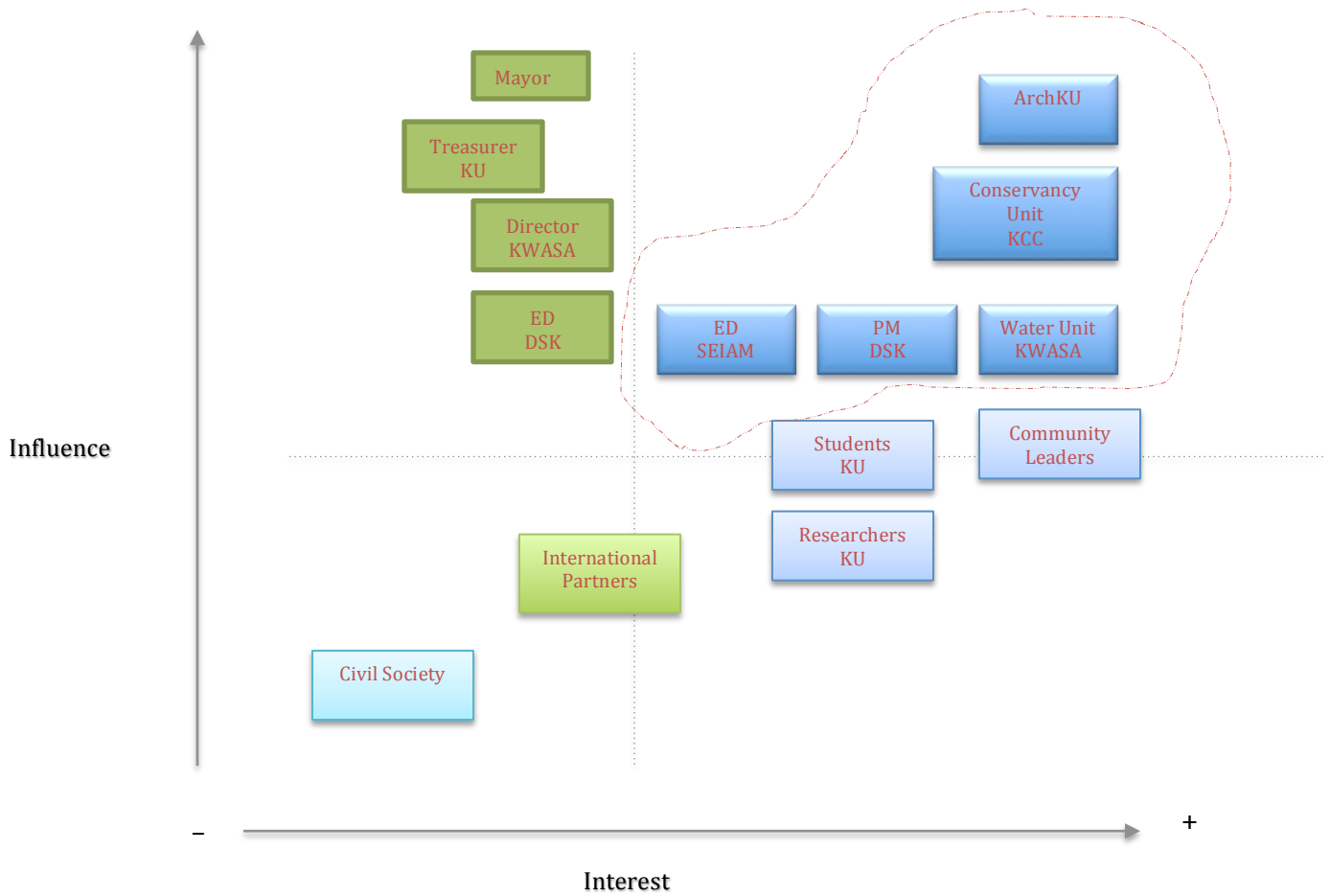


Figure 01: Stakeholders mapping based on Interest and Influence
